

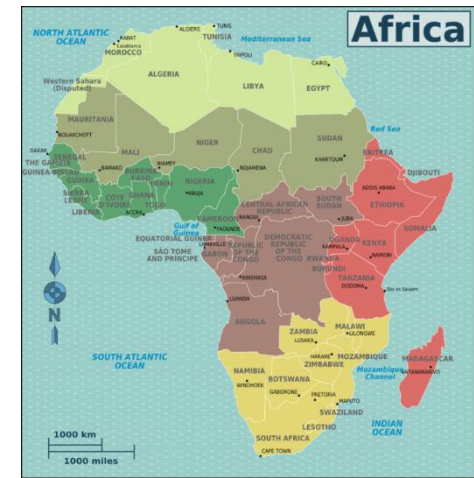

## 'Going on a Safari'

Vocabulary	Definition
Continent	A large land mass separated from other land masses by oceans
Slums	Overcrowded urban street or district inhabited by very poor people.
Poverty	The state of being extremely poor.
Settlements	A place, typically one which has previously been uninhabited, where people establish a community.
Landscapes	All the visible features of an area of land, often considered in terms of their aesthetic appeal.
Civilisation	The stage of human social and cultural development and organization that is considered most advanced.
Society	The aggregate of people living together in a more or less ordered community.
Physical geography features	The branch of geography concerned with natural features and phenomena of the earth's surface, as landforms, drainage features, climates, soils, and vegetation.
Human geography features	Human geography relates only to the human environment; something that is built by humans and would not have existed in nature without humans.
Apartheid	(In South Africa) a policy or system of segregation or discrimination on grounds of race.
Masai Mara tribe	A Nilotic ethnic group inhabiting northern, central and southern Kenya and northern Tanzania.
