

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal hours.

Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school;
- engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- is practical and smart;
- identifies the children with the school;
- prevents children from coming to school in fashion clothes that could be distracting in class;
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by parents;
- is designed with health and safety in mind.

Key Stage 2	Games During Autumn/Spring tracksuits/sweatshirts are acceptable for outdoor games. Outdoor foot wear is essential and where appropriate football boots are required. During the summer term the indoor P.E. kit and trainers are appropriate for outdoor games.
Footwear	Black shoes with a sensible heel height. In summer, closed toed sandals are acceptable. Open toed sandals are not acceptable.
Haircuts	We request that when boys have their hair cut, fashionable 'lines/patterns' are not to be worn during term time.
